Sales of Spanish wines were once driven by curiosity – but now savvy shoppers know that Spain produces, pound for pound, some of the world's most intriguing wines. Seeking to position itself as the new darling of the wine world, Spain embarked on a bold qualitative initiative embracing the latest techniques and a genuine desire to compete at the top of the world's wine stage. The result: Spanish wines exploded onto the US wine market.

Spain has over sixty DOs and almost all of them are producing interesting, and in many cases, superb wines. Several of the most important wine regions (Rioja, Ribera del Duero, and Priorat) have far surpassed their traditional value-driven bottlings to create world-class luxury cuvées. But many of these luxury cuvées became so limited and expensive that the consumer really never got the chance to experience them.

Now, thanks to our close ties to key importers, and aided by a sluggish economy, we've scored some amazing deals on several of our favorite wines. With prices that are 30% to 45% off their original lists (and with 4 out of 5 wines being the best price on the web), now is the time to own a few of these blockbusters.

2007 Finca Mirador Priorat \$14.95 (\$24 list) - **Best Price on Web!***

89 points Josh Reynolds (*International Wine Cellar*): "(55% garnacha and 45% carinena) Deep red. Seductive, mineral-driven aromas of red berries, pencil lead, spice cake and dried flowers. Light-bodied, sweet red fruit flavors are firm by dusty tannins and lifted by blood orange and white pepper. Graceful and brisk Priorat wine with a firm, mineral quality to the finish. (Sep/Oct 2009)"

2007 Buil & Giné Priorat \$16.95 (\$24 list) - **Best Price on Web!**

91 points *Wine & Spirits*: "Half of the fruit for this juicy blend comes from young vines, half from old-vine Carinena and Garnacha. The fruit is delightfully red, prettier and more accessible than what has become typical in Priorat. There's refinement to the acidity that lends the wine its nerve. For roast partridge. (Oct 2009)"

2006 Mas Doix Priorat Salanques \$24.95 (\$40 list) - **Best Price on Web (almost)!**

93 points Jay Miller (*Wine Advocate*): "The Salanques cuvee is the second wine of Celler Mas Doix, a barrel by barrel declassification from Mas Doix itself. The 2006 Salanques is a blend of 65% Garnacha, 15% Carinena, and the balance Syrah, Merlot, and Cabernet Sauvignon aged for 14 months in French oak. It offers up an enticing nose of cedar, pencil lead, tar, licorice, and black cherry. Dense, layered, and pleasure-bent on the palate, this well balanced wine will provide pleasure over the next eight years. (Jun 2009)"

2005 Ripoll Sans Priorat Closa Battlet \$28.95 (\$55 list) - **Best Price on Web!**

94 points Jay Miller (*Wine Advocate*): "The 2005 Closa Battlet is a blend of 65% Carinena, 22% Garnacha, and the balance Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and Syrah. It was aged for 15 months in French and American oak. It offers up a classy nose of cedar, liquid minerals, lavender, cinnamon, blueberry, and black cherry. Layered on the palate with silky tannin, this rich, full-flavored effort has great concentration and a lengthy, pure finish. Give it 2-3 years of additional cellaring and drink it through 2020. (Jun 2009)"



2007 Mas Doix Priorat Costers de Viñas Viejas \$79.95 (\$125 list) - **Best Price on Web!**
95 points Jay Miller (*Wine Advocate*): "The flagship, the 2007 Costers de Vinas Viejas is a blend of 50% Carinena, 48% Garnacha, and 2% Merlot aged for 16 months in new French oak. It offers up an aromatic array of smoke, mineral, leather, licorice, incense, plum, and black cherry. This leads to a full-bodied, voluminous, plush wine with a youthful personality and enough structure to evolve for 3-4 years. This lengthy effort will be at its best from 2013 to 2022 if not longer. (Apr 2010)"
