**Durieu Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2007 \$29.95** (List \$40)

90 points Robert Parker: "A sleeper of the vintage, the reasonably priced 2007 Chateaufeu du Pape is a blend of 80% Grenache and the rest primarily Mourvedre and a small amount of Syrah. The Grenache is aged in concrete vats, and the Syrah and Mourvedre spend time in small barrels. This dense ruby/purple-colored 2007 exhibits a big, sweet nose of white chocolate, black currants, garrigue, pepper, and Asian spices, supple tannins, a deep, full-bodied mouthfeel, and good freshness as well as precision. It is a hefty yet elegant Chateaufeu du Pape that should drink nicely for 10-12+ years."



**Domaine de la Solitude Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2007 \$36.95** (List \$50)

93 points Robert Parker: "The deeply-colored 2007 Chateaufeu du Pape is a blend of 55% Grenache, 30% Syrah, and 15% Mourvedre aged 80% in tank and 20% in small barrels. The 2007 is the finest traditional Chateaufeu since the glorious 1967. Its dense ruby/purple color is followed by a sensational perfume of kirsch, cassis liqueur, plums, licorice, roasted herbs, and meat juices. Seriously endowed, full-bodied, broad, savory, and layered, this is a huge, rich, massive wine that will benefit from 2-3 years of cellaring, and last for two decades or more. A sleeper of the vintage, it is one of the region's best bargains if measuring dollars per points."

**Vaudieu Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2007 \$39.95**

92 points Robert Parker: "The 2007 Chateaufeu du Pape is a full-bodied, exceptionally aromatic effort displaying plenty of sweet black cherry, licorice, garrigue, and earth as well as a subtle note of oak in a full-bodied, opulent style. As the wine sits in the glass, whiffs of raspberries and figs also emerge from this substantial, fleshy, irresistible Chateaufeu du Pape. Enjoy it over the next 10-15 years."

**Vieille Julienne Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2007 \$59.95** (List \$80)

95 points Robert Parker: "While the beautiful 2007 Chateaufeu du Pape is already accessible, it will benefit from 2-3 years of cellaring, and should last for two decades or more. It exhibits an inky/ruby/purple color, a great texture, and a gorgeous nose of boysenberries, blueberries, blackberries, acacia flowers, licorice, and incense. There is wonderful freshness and vibrancy (because of the good acids) as well as a terrific finish."

**Beaucastel Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2007 \$84.95** (List \$125)

96 points Robert Parker: "Beaucastel's 2007 Chateauneuf du Pape has turned out even better out of bottle than I predicted. An inky/ruby/purple color is followed by a glorious nose of blue and black fruits, truffles, pen ink, licorice, and meat juices as well as glorious levels of acidity and sweet tannin, buttressing the fruit's fabulous freshness and vibrancy. This full-bodied effort still displays considerable tannin, no doubt because of the relatively high Mourvedre content. It should resolve its tannins in 2-4 years, and last for 25 or more."

**Sabon Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Secret des Sabon 2007 \$219.95** (List \$250)

98+ points Rhone Report: "A gorgeous bottle of wine, the 2007 Roger Sabon Châteauneuf-du-Pape Le Secret des Sabon is filled with blackberry and cassis fruit that's intermixed with seared meat, blood, spice, licorice and garrigue aromas. With air, this picks up graphite, charcoal and mineral nuances and it's perfumed, ripe and decadent. The palate is full bodied and perfectly balanced with stunning fruit, a thick texture, fresh acids and a blockbuster finish. I'd give this 5 to 7 years and then drink over the following 25+."
